## What is the Sharing Place?

The Sharing Place is a material assistance program, The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) participant, and Gleaners Food Bank Pantry Partner providing free food and clothing to families in need in Lawrence Township. Located inside the Lawrence Township Community and Education Center, the Sharing Place is staffed by volunteers recruited from the community and local churches.

The Sharing Place Food Pantry is a program of the Foundation for Lutheran Child and Family Services, a 501(c)3 charitable organization.







### Who We Serve

The Sharing Place serves individuals of all ages in the following Marion County ZIP codes:

Clients are eligible to receive food once a month and are eligible for an additional visit on the second Saturday of each month. Food assistance services do not require a referral, but do require proof of residence at each visit, such as a piece of mail or current government issued ID.

### How You Can Help

The Sharing Place accepts monetary donations and gifts-in-kind. Cash donations are used to purchase food through local partnerships and to cover day-to-day operating costs involved in keeping the food pantry open to the community. The Sharing Place purchases food at cost from Gleaner's Food Bank, which sources food and coordinates delivery to Pantry Partners in Central Indiana.

The Sharing Place also accepts donations of pantry staples, like canned food and dry goods, and even fresh food from many of our friends' gardens!

In addition to fresh food and pantry staples, The Sharing Place accepts donations of lightlyused clothes, shoes and coats for children from infancy to 18 years of age.

Volunteers are the lifeblood of of the Sharing Place! Volunteers are always needed to stock shelves, shop with clients, and pick up food from area grocery stores and food banks. ## Additional Outreach Programs

**Ready, Set, Learn!** is a back-to-school program which provides two school uniforms to children from low-income households referred by their socail worker.

The Schneider National Carriers Thanks-Give-Away: Each Thanksgiving, Schneider National Carriers purchases non-perishable, traditional Thanksgiving food, and uses our Chapel and network of social workers to give food to families in need.

**The Christmas Store** is a Christmas assistance program by referral during which individuals are given the opportunity to "shop" for Christmas gifts for their families.

The Emergency Diaper Dispensary (TEDD) provides diapers to families in need. Diapers are distributed by referral only and must be picked up by the referring social worker.

## Other Lutheran Child and Family Services Programs

**Lutherwood** - A Secure, residential treatment facility for boy and girls aged 6 to 18 years, who are of traumatic events and require a secure, 24/7 treatment setting. Lutherwood features an on-site school for residents accredited by Indianapolis Public Schools, a gym and a courtyard for recreational activities.

<u>IMPACT</u> - Secure, residential therapeutic treatment for teen female survivors of sex trafficking.

Emergency Shelter Care - A 24/7 safe haven for up to 16 boys and girls aged 13-18 who require temporary shelter from abusive or unsafe home situations.

<u>Trinity House</u> - a non-secure group home for boys aged 16-21 learning independent living skills and completing highschool or a GED.

<u>Community Based Services</u> - A referral based counseling service for families in their homes and on-site for domestic violence, substance abuse and parenting skills counseling.

<u>SEED (Spiritual Engagement, Education</u>
<u>& Development)</u> - An open and inclusive spiritual growth program for residents and staff of LCFS of any faith or tradition.
